Best known as the dam of SAF 598 Bando 5175, SAF Royal Lass 1002 is also the dam of the \$25,000 SydGen Prestige 1316, top-selling bull in our 2002 production sale. She is regarded as one of the breed's top growth females, ranking in the top 1% of current dams for WW, YW, \$F, and SC EPDs even as she nears 14 years of age. Our 2004 sale will include a direct daughter by PAPA Durabull 9805 as well as sons by SAF Connection, SAF Hi Choice, and Feltons Meat Packer 62. We have several top daughters of 1002 in production, and maternal granddaughters will sell by SAF Connection, SAF Focus of ER, and Leachman Boom Time.
