Besides the immortal SAF 598 Bando 5175, she has produced SydGen Ally 2235 at Graupman's, SydGen Prestige 1316 for Daltons on the Sycamore and Jim Davis, SydGen Meat Packer 3528 at Summitcrest, Ranger G 154 at Destiny Angus, SAF Charmer at Larkota Angus, SAF 30-06 at Big Dry Angus Ranch, SAF Cash 7203 at Mogck's Angus, SydGen Diversity 2425 at Pine Ridge, SydGen Sterling 3229 at Frank and Craig Schaefer's, and SydGen Alliance 2260 at Wittkop's. She is also the dam of the \$100,000 SAF Royal Lass 5158, and SydGen Royal Lass 2404, one of the top young cows at Beaver Ridge Farms.

1002's production record includes 7 natural calves weaned at 111 ratio, 6 yearlings at 107, and 24 progeny scanned with ratios of 104 for IMF, 101 for REA, 97 for ribfat, and 94 for rumpfat.

Featured in our upcoming production sale will be a fall yearling bull by Future Direction, and direct daughters by Future Direction, Bushwacker, and Lead On, as well as numerous other maternal descendants.

produced the curve-bending SAF Fame as her first natural calf, and continues to produce top herd sires, including Wintergreen's SAF Sequoia, SAF Factor at ABS Global, SydGen E161 Precision 1485 at Legacy Land and Cattle, and SydGen VNAR Dundee ZB at Ron Smith's. 1027 is owned with Zelinko Brothers and Joe Van Nice, and her 6 natural calves balance an average birth ratio of 99, weaning ratio of 105, and yearling ratio of 103. 46 progeny scanned average 99 for IMF, 101 for REA, 97 for ribfat and 89 for rumpfat. Several daughters have been flushed here, and daughters are serving as donors for Ray Cattle Co. and Bob Chase.

Featured in our upcoming production sale will be daughters by Sitz Alliance 6595, B/R New Dimension 7127, SydGen Eclipse 2478, and Papa Forte 1921, along with many other maternal descendants.

Also on display for the tour will be SAF Royal Lass 0062, the year-older natural full sister to 1027 and 1002 who was the "inspiration" for this flush that also included our popular pen of bulls in the Midland 1992 offering.
