Their dam is a top young donor in our program, stemming from the same cow family as SAF Focus of ER. Their maternal brother, SydGen Trust 6228, is the only sire on the young sire summary to rank in the top 1% for \$W, \$B and REA, and he has tested exceptionally high on the Pfizer HD50K MVPs, ranking in the top 1% for CED, CEM, Marbling, REA and their \$Index, as well as in the top 8% for NFI.
