

# Longevity - Soundness - Fertility - Calving-Ease Efficiency - Docility - Pounds - Carcass Merit - Maternal

All of these traits are important to commercial breeders, and few bulls can bring it all to the table. LIBERTY is the only bull on the main sire summary who ranks in the top 10% for CED, RADG, Scrotal, Docility and Heifer Pregnancy (and he actually ranks in the top 2% and 3% for Docility and HP). LIBERTY also ranks in the top 10% for REA, and misses the top 10% on WW and YW EPDs by one pound, as of this writing. We expect his Mature Weight and Height EPDs to move down when his first daughters wear their calves this spring, just as his sire did when his first daughters came into production. Phenotypically sound and free-moving, he was named Grand Champion Bull at the 2010 Missouri State Fair, after selling half interest for \$48,000 in the November 2009 SydGen Production Sale, as the top-selling half interest bull of that fall sale season. His first 9 steer progeny harvested earned a 78% CAB® certification rate and average CW of 925 lbs. He is the most highly-proven son of the now-deceased \$160,000 Connealy Forward. LIBERTY is currently standing at ORigen in Huntley, MT. Owned with Wiederstein Pure Angus Farm, Audubon, IA, and Greiner Angus, Kalona, IA.
