For our Futurity consignment, we have historically offered our top two-year-old fall heifer calf pair, and this female brings the history and EPD excellence to rise to the top. She is sired by the rare and valuable SydGen 928 Destination 5420, "Whiskey," whose 12 sons and daughters in our 2015 production sale averaged \$12,117. Despite limited usage, "Whiskey" has three sons along with himself, ranked in the top 36 \$B Sires in the breed, at +193 or better. 3768's dam is the powerful Lot 1 Mandate daughter in our 2014 offering that brought \$30,000 to Herbst Angus Farm, Falls City, NE, and her grandam is our record-valuation female whose first calf was the popular SydGen CC&7. 3768 scored single digit genomic scores for WW, YW, YH and CW to help her earn top 1% rankings for WW, YW, CW, Milk, \$W, \$F and \$B. She sells open and ready to flush, and her September heifer calf by OCC Ultimate Answer 118 will also sell.

This fall yearling son of GAR Missouri 5761 was shown by Chase last summer, and was named Reserve Senior Calf Champion in the Missouri State Fair FFA Show. He has continued to develop into an exceptionally thick individual, with loads of muscle expression. He earned a BWR of 83 and a WWR of 104, as the natural calf out of his dam that was the 2010 Missouri State Fair FFA Grand Champion Female, going on to earn a progeny record of 4 BR-96, 4 WR-107, 3 YR-102 and 7 REA-101. Maternal brother brought \$7,500 in our 2014 sale to Smith Angus Farm, Snow Creek, NC.
