Sixty-six first calf heifers were pastured together last summer. All heifers were home raised and all calves sired by Connealy Cool 39L. Calves were born between February 22 and March 5, 2017. They had an average weight of 605/lb/hd on September 18.

254 brothers of heifers offered were fed at Irsik & Doll, Garden City, KS. 98% graded Choice or higher.

Operational History

Mershon Cattle is a commercial cattle operation run by the Mershon family in Jackson County, Missouri. This year is the fifth consecutive year that our bred heifers have been in the Sydgen Influence Commercial Heifer Sale. We have used Sydgen bulls and semen since 2004. The herd consists of Angus based, cross-bred cows that have been AI bred using Hereford and Charolais semen. Steers are retained and sold on the grid. All heifers offered are from our home-raised cows.

Herd Health

Prior to weaning in 2016:

- Two rounds of Bovi-Shield Gold One Shot
- One round Ultrabac 7/Somubac
- One round Ultrabac 7
- Two rounds of Pinkeye vaccine

April 22, 2017:

- Pelvic measured and track scored
- Treated with Bovi-Shield Gold FP5 VL5 & Pinkeye
- Wormed with LongRange

October 26, 2017:

- Sonogramed for pregnancy and treated with Vira Shield 6 VL5, Scour Bos 9, Pinkeye, & Ivermectin

March 16, 2018:

- Lee's Summit Animal Hospital reconfirmed all bred heifers in third period
