Decades of multi-trait selection culminated in an impressive representation of Sydenstricker Genetics on the May 31 debut of the \$Combined (\$C) Index and the \$Maternal (\$M) Index, as well as an update in the calculations for \$Beef (\$B).

\$C can be accessed on member login for owned animals. Computations of **\$C** for the Main and Young Sire Summaries were done using the formula provided.

- The SydGen Cow Herd has 61 dams that rank in the top 1% for \$C, led by SydGen Forever Lady 1255, with \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 2% and \$C of \$353. She is the dam of SydGen Exceed and flush sister to SydGen 5420 Destination 1315.
- **SydGen Enhance** earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 10% and \$C of \$378 to give him the Number 1 ranking on the Main Sire Summary.
- SydGen Exceed 3223 earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 4% and \$C of \$335, ranking 8th on the Main Sire Summary.
- SydGen Blacksmith 4010 earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 35% and \$C of \$335, ranking 8th on the Main Sire Summary.
- **SydGen 5420 Destination 1315** earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 25% and \$C of \$333, ranking 10th on the Main Sire Summary.
- SydGen FATE 2800 earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 50% and \$C of \$316.
- SydGen Atlas 1043, SydGen Black Pearl 2006, BCA Jack Black 4112, SydGen Wake Up Call 9446, EXAR Stud 4658B, SydGen CC&7 and SydGen Straight Up 8998 are all on the Main Sire Summary with rankings in the top 2 to 5% for \$C.
- **Connealy Cool 39L** posted the second highest \$M on the Main Sire Summary at +\$104, helping him earn a \$C of +273 to rank in the top 10% of proven sires.
- **SydGen Faith 6023** earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 40% and \$C of \$356 to rank second on the Young Sire Summary.
- SydGen Black Pearl 6073, SydGen Big League and SydGen Exceed 5164 all rank in the top 20 or higher on the Young Sire Summary for \$C, with values of \$344, \$329 and \$319 respectively.
- **HPCA Early Bird 65** earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 30% and \$C of \$324 to rank 13th on the Young Sire Summary.
- BCA Jeremiah 5103 earned \$B in the top 4%, \$M in the top 1% and \$C of \$319 to rank 24th on the Young Sire Summary.
- Bakers Northside 6007, whose first calves are just now being weaned, earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 10% and \$C of +\$335.
- SydGen Evolution earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 75% and \$C of \$342.
- SydGen Merit 6553 earned \$B in the top 2%, \$M in the top 1% and \$C of \$337.
- SydGen Bonus 8084 earned \$B in the top 1%, \$M in the top 10% and \$C of \$341.
- SydGen Resolve 7132 earned \$B in the top 3%, \$M in the top 4% and \$C of \$313.
