Her great grandam is a flush sister to SAF NEUTRON, the big scrotal cow-maker now best known as the grandsire of the record-selling, high-scanning sire BR Midland.

Her September 13 heifer calf at side is by SAF BANKER, the flush brother to SAF Royal Queen 5084, making SydGen Duchess 4566 linebred for high scrotal, curve-bending genetics. SydGen Duchess 2454 produced three transferable embryos on December 9, 2004, and will be A.I. bred to SydGen 1407 CORONA 2016.
