

Volume + Muscle + Maternal = Opportunity

Each year, we select what we feel is our very top fall-calving two year old to feature in the Missouri Angus Futurity, one with the heritage and the phenotype for donor material. This daughter of the \$28,000 SydGen Bouncer 2458 is the right kind. Her sire was selected from our 2003 Sale as the second top-selling bull by Wiederstein Pure Angus Farm, Audubon, IA, from a flush of six bulls that grossed \$109,000 that day. Bouncer's first daughters are now in production, and his progeny exhibit excellent muscle shape and correctness while already earning their sire a \$B Value well into the top 1% of current sires. 5741's dam produced a \$10,600 son to Roger Hill and Olsen Acres, Grand Mound, IA, served as a SydGen donor, compiled a progeny record of 3 BR-95, 3 WR-110, 3 YR-108, 13 IMF-93, and 13 uREA-105, and is now an integral part of the donor program for C/S Cattle Company, Pomona, MO. Her grandam, GDAR Miss Wix 3325, was one of our "pick" heifers from the Gartner-Denowh program at Sidney, MT. This high maternal daughter of Traveler 3173 GDAR produced SAF Phantom, the top-selling bull calf in our 1995 sale to Sweeney Angus and Strathe Angus in Iowa, that was later leased to Alta Genetics. A flush from 3325 that sold to Pollard Farms in Oklahoma, produced the 2000 National Junior Heifer Show Senior Heifer Calf Champion as well as many top descendants in their program. 3325 was also the top-selling cow in our 2000 Sale at \$14,000 to Riverbend Ranch, Idaho. SAF Miss Wix 5741 sells in her entirety, with an October 31 heifer calf at side by SydGen Journey 4355. She will sell open and ready to flush.
