

# Consigning Our Best... to the Missouri Angus Futurity

**SydGen Anita 8611 is a powerful, functional female who combines all the phenotypic and performance traits that make the Angus cow dominant in the beef cattle industry.**

**As the dominant female from our Fall 2008 calf crop, Anita has proven her ability to excel on every phenotypic and performance standard.**

From our first full calf crop by the \$160,000 top-selling bull of the Angus breed in 2007, this female dominated our 87 head of fall replacement heifers, posting the Number 1 actual yearling weight, the Number 1 %IMF scan, and the third largest actual REA at 14.4 sq. in. She accomplished all of that in a low-input environment, then settled on her first service AI, and calved unassisted on September 8, 2010, with a **SydGen Sure Bet** heifer calf. Her pedigree, from the same family that produced BCC Bushwacker 41-93, is as solid as can be, and offers limitless outcross opportunities. Anita 8611 produced 8 transferable embryos in her first flush, and will sell open and ready to flush. The dam of Anita 8611 records 4 WR@110, 4 YR@106, 4 IMF@111 and 4 REA@103, and joined her daughter in the donor pen this fall.
