

# Grass-Time is the Best Time!

**Herd bulls are kicked out, and we are taking some time to analyze sire groups to start planning for our 41st Annual Production Sale on November 23!**

- Enhance continues to be one of the breed's most popular and widely-used AI sires and his EPD profile defines multi-trait excellence. His first 25 progeny to sell at SydGen have averaged \$15,954 and his sons and daughters have topped several other breeder sales this spring.
- Exceed sired a \$150,000 daughter in last September's Ankony "Only the Tops" sale in Georgia, a \$34,000 daughter in the Stevens sale in Oklahoma and a \$15,000 son in the recent Spring Grove Ranch sale in Virginia. Exceed's maternal sister produced the \$140,000 top-selling female in the recent Crazy K Ranch sale in Tennessee.
- 15 SydGen sires rank in the top 200 \$B Sires on the Main Sire Summary and 11 of them will have progeny in our next production sale.
- FATE continues to prove himself as one of the breed's elite high-accuracy multi-trait sires, with daughters in our fall sale bringing \$20,000 and \$18,000.
- Black Pearl, Cool, Blacksmith, Fastlane, Stud, Wake Up Call and Rock Star continue to produce high-performing calves and their early daughters in production are doing what they are bred to do.
- The first calves at SydGen by Patriarch and Northside are getting considerable positive comments for their performance and structure.

The 14th Annual SydGen Influence Sale grossed \$248,350 on 70 bulls to average \$3547. All three of the top-selling bulls were sons of SydGen Enhance, followed by sons of Exceed, Stud, Generation 6267 and Clockwork. Top-selling bull at \$15,500 was consigned by Griffin Angus, Monroe City, MO and sold to Juan Carlos Barrajas, Guadalajara, Mexico. Other top bulls were consigned by Borkowski & Carney Angus, Adair, IA; Graupman Angus, Palmyra, MO and Eggers Stock Farm, Jackson, MO. 13 commercial two-year-old pairs from Mershon Cattle LLC, Buckner, MO averaged \$2,666. Several of these were daughters of Trust and Cool, with calves at-side by SydGen bulls.

A big thank you to De-Su Angus, New Albin, IA for purchasing the top-selling female at the 2019 Missouri Angus Futurity, a Stud daughter, for \$20,000. Her fall Enhance daughter at-side brought \$8,000 to Greiner Angus, Kalona, IA.

Tom Sackman, Chadron, NE purchased 3 IVF embryos by Enhance out of 44 Rita 4794 for \$750 apiece.

Chase Monte sold the Grand Champion Bull of the day to Suzy Moore, Auxvasse, MO and two Primo show heifer prospects to Reed Gooden, Lone Jack, MO and Emily Bruns, Thompson, MO.
