This top coming four-year-old has been flushed once, resulting in 10 transferable embryos, and her first calf is one of our very best fall bred heifers. A maternal brother, SydGen Express 3487B, was slated to be our lead sale bull in 2014 before his untimely death and with just a few AI progeny, currently records \$B of +191.42, as well as being the sire of the top-selling bull in our 2016 offering, SydGen Expansion 5917.
