Heifer Pairs Information

Approximately 34 fall heifer pairs to sell immediately following bred heifers. Most are black Angus-cross with a couple of Black Baldy heifers. All with calf at side. Calves' tags match their mother's tags. Calves are sired from SydGen Angus bulls and are 30-60 days old. Calves vaccinated with Naselgen 3 PMH and given shot of Draxxin prior to the sale.

Mershon Cattle is a commercial cattle operation run by the Mershon family in Jackson County, Missouri. This is the 10th consecutive year that our bred heifers have been offered at the SydGen Bred Heifer Sale. Our focus on quality genetics has helped us produce a high-performing herd.
